Under normal circumstances, if within 14 working days from the date below, 10 electors from the parish ward gave notice in writing to the Returning Officer at Electoral Services Office, Shute End, Wokingham a by-election to fill the vacancy would have been held.

At the present time, Section 58 of the Coronavirus Bill has postponed elections, including casual vacancies. Therefore, it will not be possible to run a by-election should one be requested. However, if a notice is received, the vacancy would be held until such time as legislation comes into force allowing postponed elections to be run.

If no such notice is given to the Returning Officer, the Parish Council will fill the post by co-option.
