Twyford Parish Council and volunteers from the village are creating a Neighbourhood Plan to put in place planning policy to guide future development. A Neighbourhood Plan is a legal document and, once approved, Wokingham Borough Council must take it into consideration when planning future development in Twyford.

The Neighbourhood Plan must reflect the views of the community so we will be asking for your opinion on which issues are important to you, as well as your thoughts about how the village will be in the future. We are developing a questionnaire for the New Year and we would greatly appreciate a few moments of your time to fill it out.

Once a draft Plan has been created it will be validated by both Wokingham Borough Council and an appointed Planning Inspector, and then the final step is for the whole village to have the opportunity to vote to adopt the Plan. The whole process is anticipated to be completed in 2020.

Our questionnaire will be published in early 2019 and every household within the Parish boundary will be able to complete it on paper or online.
