Twyford Parish Council Highways Meeting Notes

A meeting hosted by Wokingham Borough Council held at 11:30am on Friday 4th November 2022 via Teams.

Attendees: Martin Heath (Wokingham Borough Council), Matthew Gould (Wokingham Borough Council), Charles Wickenden (Twyford Parish Council), Bridget Ditcham (Twyford Parish Council) & Lynn Povey (Assistant Clerk to Twyford Parish Council).

1. Welcome.

Mr M Gould welcomed everyone to the meeting and handed over to Mr M Heath to lead.

2. Apologies:

Chris Easton (Wokingham Borough Council).

- 3. Village Centre Traffic Improvements. Discussion points as follows:
 - 3.1 Heavy Goods Vehicle ban.
 - Environmental Ban (TPC). Carried forward.
 - Declassification from A-Roads to B-Roads (MH). WBC to investigate the environmental impact – Surveys of the A3032 to be arranged and alternative routes to direct traffic to be looked at.
 - Direction signage within village (WBC). WBC to complete an inventory of highway signs within Twyford.
 - **Parking facilities Need for increase.** Update from WBC following the consultation. The commencement of the consultation was delayed actual start date was 29.10.22 & will run for 6-weeks. WBC Officers to be available to the public in Twyford Library once a week to discuss proposals (https://engage.wokingham.gov.uk/en-GB/projects/twyford-parking-survey).
 - 3.3 Blanket 20MPH through Village Update on trial being carried out in Wargrave (WBC). It was reported that surveys have been carried out in Wargrave Public Consultation to commence in the new year.

4. Gateways.

- **4.1 Old Bath Road** 40MPH signs missing. WBC to investigate Mrs L Povey to email details
- **4.2 Heritage Sign** Update (WBC). Mr M Heath confirmed that the contractors no longer have the sign and finding a manufacturer to make a like for like sign has proven unsuccessful.
- **Twyford/Hurst border Can Cuincy be added?** Update on quotes (MH). Mr M Heath provided the following approximate costs for 'Twinned with Cuincy' to be added to both sides of the Hurst Road gateway for consideration:
 - Overlay and installation £200
 - Additional Plate and installation £1200

Further costings to be provided for a 'Community Speed Watch' sign.

5. Streetlamps.

- **5.1 Non-WBC Lamps** Update on ownership consideration (WBC).
 - It was confirmed that WBC were not minded to take over ownership To clarify/forward communication.
 - Mr M Heath raised the option of introducing Part-Time Lighting to help reduce costs – checks to be made with the Street Lighting Team to see who would be responsible for finding out the crime rates, carrying out surveys etc.
- **Turn your engine off signs** Update (WBC). WBC to get contractors to remove all of the signs from the village along with developer signs.
- **6.** Speeding on the Wargrave Road & Hurst Road To discuss speed calming options. WBC to arrange for surveys to be carried out.

- 7. Safe Route to School/Pedestrian Crossing (Wargrave Road) Update following reappraisal (WBC). WBC to locate a suitable site between Longfield Road & the A4 for a survey to be carried out.
- 8. A4 Speeding/Safe Route Update (TPC).
 - WBC to arrange a meeting with the Police who have been investigating speeds etc and report back.
 - TPC to liaise with Cllr Paul Fishwick (Executive Member for Highways).
- 9. Parking on pavements & verges Update (WBC):
 - 9.1 Longfield Road with Hilltop Road Junction.
 - 9.2 Colleton Drive Outside School.
 - 9.3 London Road Outside shops.

No notices have been issued. To inform WBC of any problematic areas.

- **10. Bridge Copse Boundary Fence** Mrs B Ditcham raised health & safety concerns regarding the broken/missing fencing in the area opposite the Waggon & Horses. WBC to investigate who is responsible for the fencing and report back.
- **11. London Road bench Outside Almhouses** Mr M Heath to investigate repairs.
