Minutes of a meeting of the Planning and Amenities Committee held at Loddon Hall, Twyford on Tuesday 5th December 2023 at 7:45pm

- 5. Minutes
- 5.1 Minutes of the meeting held on 7th November 2023 Approval of the minutes as a true and accurate record. Proposed by Mrs E Ashley, seconded by Mr M Andrea, carried nem con.
- 6. Matters Arising and Action Points.
- 6.1 Speedwatch Update. Mrs E Ashley reported that at least 14 members are needed to form a group To consider linking with other local parishes. Mr F Newman to gauge interest from Ruscombe Parish Council. Deputy Clerk also advised that a response is being awaited from Thames Valley Police. Item carried forward.
- 6.2 To consider the removal of the unused village CCTV units. It was proposed by Mr M Alder, seconded by Mr M Andrea and unanimously approved that the Deputy Clerk obtains costings for the removal of the units; to reinstate the units and to replace the units. To be discussed in the next meeting.
- 6.3 Tree sponsorship (circulated). Awaiting response from WBC Carried forward.
- 6.4 Berkshire Nature Recovery Survey (CW). Mr C Wickenden confirmed that he had replied to the survey and provided an overview of the response.

It was proposed by Mr F Newman, seconded by Mrs E Ashley and unanimously agreed that the main Twyford Parish Council noticeboard should change from being the one sited in Amberley Drive to the one sited on Apsley House (side of Rural Pie). - 11.2 To consider re-numbering TPC owned streetlamp columns:
 - To supply stickers (172 x £1.50) & staffing costs to apply stickers £558.
 - For WBC contractors to supply & place stickers £1912.30 (quote provided Nov '21). It was proposed by Mr M Alder, seconded by Mrs E Ashley, and unanimously agreed for the Deputy Clerk to order the numbered stickers and arrange for their placement for £558.
- 11.3 To consider replacing the boundary sign at the Hurst Road gateway to include 'twinned with Cuincy' (designs circulated):
 - To replace the 2x boundary signs with new and including Cuincy, £740.00 total
 - 2x new speed watch boundary signs 'Black on yellow' £175.00 total

The appeal is allowed and planning permission is granted for the proposed change of use of land to a single Gypsy and Traveller pitch with the siting of 1 no. mobile home and conversion of the existing stables to a day room, plus associated parking, landscaping and gate at Land opposite 130-144 Wargrave Road, Twyford RG10 9PN in accordance with the terms of the application, Ref 230310, dated 7 February 2023, subject to the conditions set out in the attached schedule.

 - On the Waltham Road, west side just south of the junction with Winchcombe Road, encroaching into the footway by around 50% of the paved surface.
 - Broad Hinton, outside number 9. The laurel hedge is making a break for freedom! Now covering about 50-605% of the original path width.
 - Waltham Road on the west side south of the Junction with Hurst Road. Encroaching the footway and now badly restricting the sight line for traffic emerging from Hurst Road on to Waltham Road.
 - Wargrave Road. The bowls club hedge is now encroaching on and severely restricting the footway width, so only single file width available. The growth now extends beyond the line of the streetlights and dangerously restricts the sightline exiting from the La Fontana /Waitrose car parks.
